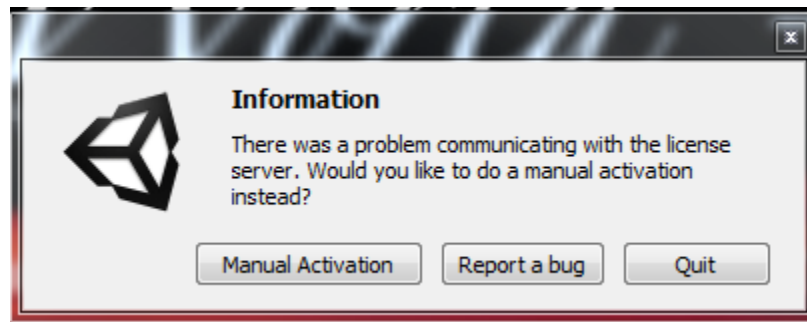
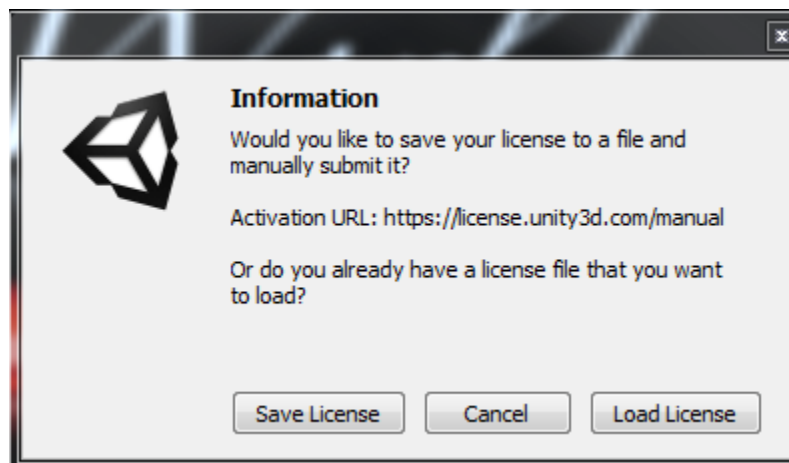


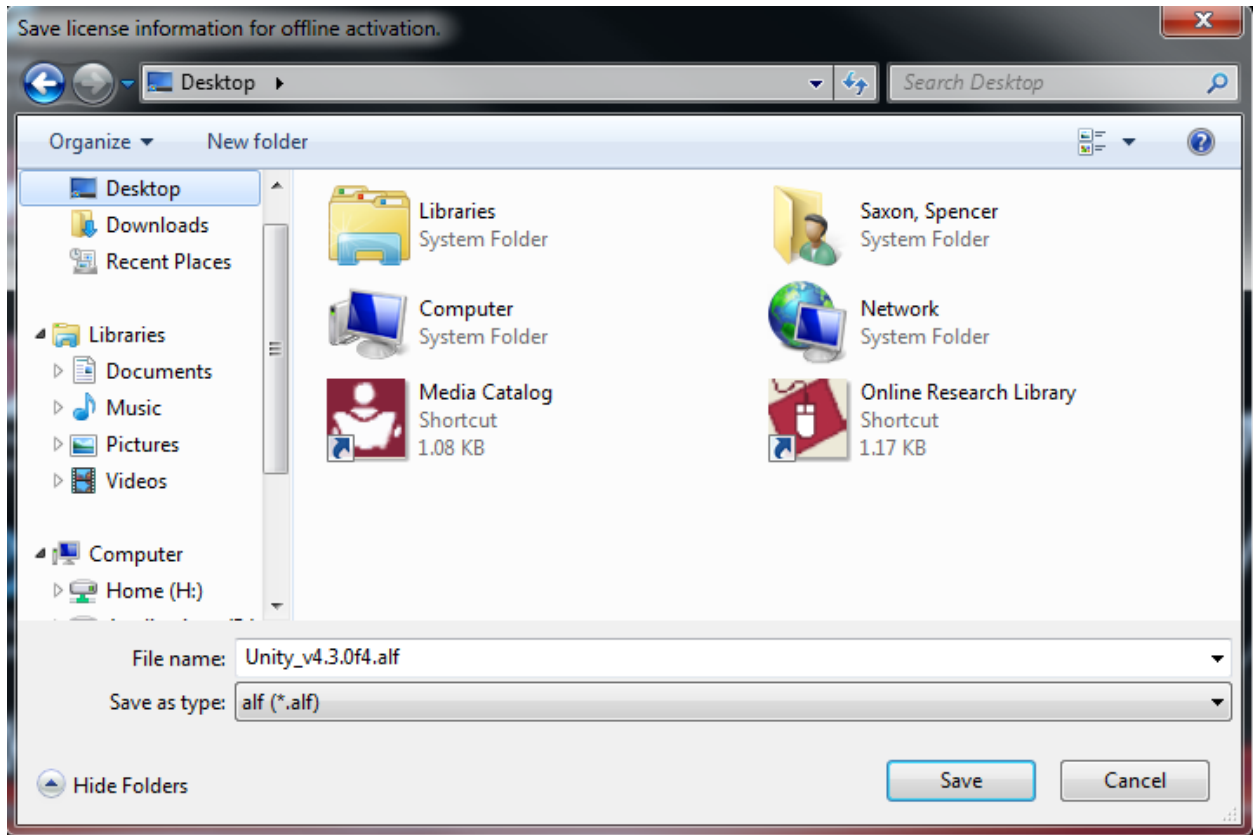
Before any of these steps, make sure Unity3D is downloaded, and installed. It should be on LHS machines.



1. Click Manual Activation

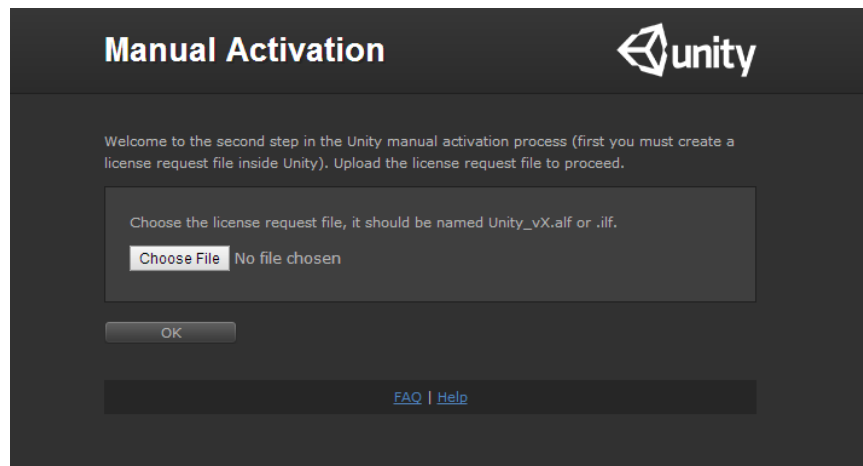


2. Click Save License. DO NOT CLOSE OUT OF THIS BOX.

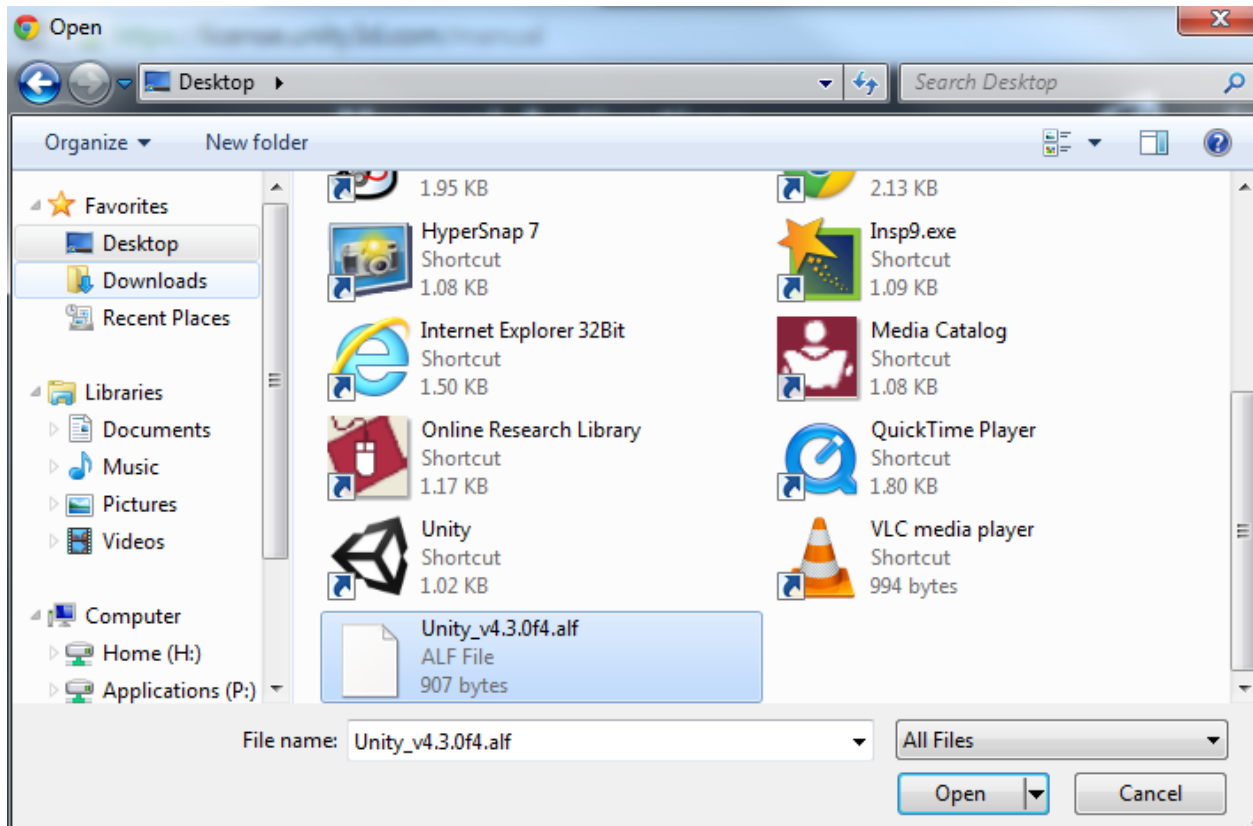


3. Save to the Desktop

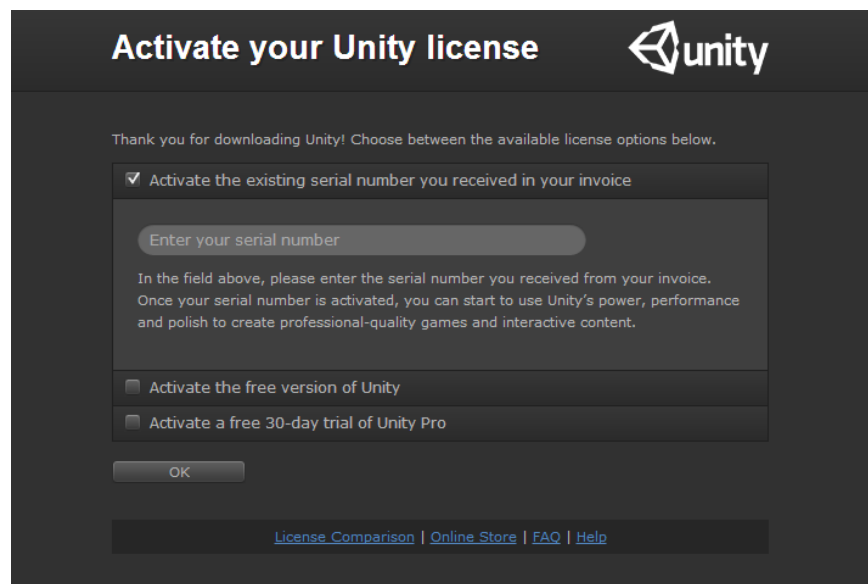
